Leave Your Nets and Follow Me | “At once they left their nets and followed him.” (Matthew 4:20)

In this Sunday’s Gospel, Jesus walks along the shore and calls ordinary people who are busy with ordinary work. “Follow me,” he says. And we hear those striking words: *they left their nets and followed him.*

There is something simple and wholehearted about that response. They don’t need perfect conditions or complete certainty. They respond to a call that comes right in the middle of everyday life.

That call is not locked in the past. It is spoken to us now, here, in our parish.

Following Jesus today often looks very practical. It means **choosing to be involved, choosing to help, choosing to give a little time** so that something bigger can flourish. A parish does not run on its own. It grows because people say yes, again and again, in ways that fit their lives.

With two churches to care for, a wide range of ages to serve, and many activities taking place, we rely on **many helping hands**. From the young to the not so young, from those who can give time regularly to those who can help occasionally, there really is a place for everyone.

Volunteering is not about doing everything. It is about doing something.

That might mean helping with children and families through Family of Faith or sacramental preparation. It might be welcoming at Mass, making tea, setting up rooms, helping with music, reading, flowers, cleaning, admin, outreach, maintenance, or simply being a friendly face who notices others. Small acts, offered faithfully, make a real difference.

Many of you already know this because you have been doing it for years. To you, we want to say a **heartfelt thank you**. Your generosity, often unseen, has helped sustain parish life through good times and difficult ones. We are deeply grateful.

To those who are newer, or who have been quietly wondering if there might be a way to get involved, this is a **gentle invitation**. You do not need to have all the answers. You do not need to be an expert. You just need to be willing.

After all Masses this weekend, there will be an opportunity to sign up to volunteer. Claire and Mary Ann will be at the back of church to gather details, answer questions, or offer a QR code

so you can register easily online. Signing up is not a commitment to do everything. It is simply the start of a conversation about how your gifts, time, and interests might be shared.

It really does take a community to run a parish. And when many people offer a little, the whole community is strengthened.

Thank you in advance to everyone who will take that step. And thank you again to all who already give so generously. Together, by leaving a few nets behind, we help make our parish a place where faith is lived, shared, and handed on.
