Welcome to Palm Sunday. Today we enter Holy Week and in Mass today, in this one liturgy, we are carried through a striking contrast. We begin with joy, welcoming Jesus with palms, celebrating his arrival. Then we hear his cry from the Cross in the Psalm: “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” And finally, we stand before the solemn reading of the Passion. From welcome to crucifixion.

The question is simple: will we stay?

Will we walk with Jesus through these days, through the Last Supper, the Cross, the silence of Holy Saturday, until we reach the joy of the Resurrection? This week is not something to watch from a distance. It is a journey to make.

Holy Week and Triduum Times.

- 28 March, Palm Sunday 6pm, Seaford
- 29 March, Palm Sunday 11am, Peacehaven
- 02 April, Maundy Thursday 7pm, Peacehaven with Vigil until Midnight
- 03 April, Good Friday 3pm, Peacehaven
- 04 April, Easter Vigil Mass 8pm, Peacehaven
- 05 April, Easter Sunday 9am Peacehaven, 11am Seaford

The Triduum is considered a single, continuous liturgy, emphasizing the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. It begins on

Maundy Thursday evening with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, continues with Good Friday's Liturgy of the Lord's Passions, and culminates with the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening.

Easter Collection and Envelopes.
