Mass Intentions - a time of transition.

A Mass intention is a special prayer offered during Holy Mass for a particular person or need, whether living or deceased. It is a beautiful expression of faith, uniting our prayers to the sacrifice of Christ. Canon Law reminds us of the obligation to celebrate Mass regularly “for the people entrusted to their care” (Canon 534).

With the introduction of our new weekend Mass schedule, some adjustments to the Mass intention rota will be necessary. Existing weekday Mass intentions will not be affected. The required “People of the Parish” Mass will alternate each week between the 9am and 11am Sunday Masses.
